All classes are open to Members and Non Members of TREC GB but only fully paid up members will have their scores counted in the TREC GB Winter Leagues.

This is a two phase competition:

The MA Phase (control of paces) demonstrates the control and obedience of the horse. The MA takes place over 50m to 150m. For the Winter Series. the MA section is awarded 50% of the points accrued.

The PTV course of 10 obstacles, simulated to represent those you might meet out hacking, designed to test the riding skills, the training of your horse and the accord between you.

Please be aware of the **Flu vaccination requirements** at the end of this schedule.

The Classes

- 1. TOP SCORE** Open to all. Competitors have a set time to do the course of 10 obstacles in the correct order and direction. Once completed, a joker obstacle is chosen which carries double marks. Then obstacles are ridden in the correct direction in any order, all obstacles can be used up to 3 times in the time limit. All the scores are added up to give an overall total. There is no MA. This is a good warm up class. The class will be split into am and pm sessions so that competitors in classes 6 and 7 do not have to wait around all day.
- 2. INTERMEDIATE**
The horse and rider combination not to have been placed first in three or more Intermediate classes, or to have won twice in the Open class at WINTER TREC competitions prior to 1st October 2018. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 2/3.
- 3. OPEN INTERMEDIATE**
Open to all horses and riders. The course will be of the same standard as Intermediate.
- 4. OPEN.**
Open to all horse and rider combinations. PTV obstacles equivalent to L3/4.
- 5. PAIRS**
Open to all. Both riders are in the arena at the same time. The first rider starts with the MA canter, then the 10 obstacles; they swap with a high-five and the second rider does the 10 obstacles and finishes with the MA walk.
- 6. NEWCOMER**
Open to RIDERS who have not been placed first in two or more Winter League classes prior to 1st October 2019. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1.
- 7 NOVICE HORSE**
Open to HORSES who have not been placed first in two or more Winter League classes prior to 1st October 2019. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1.

Each of the classes 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 above will qualify for the TREC GB national league. League points will be awarded depending on finishing position: 10 points for 1st down to 1 point for 10th place.

The highest four scores will be counted for the league. In the event of equal positions after 4 events the position at a fifth event will be taken into account. If still equal the TOTAL actual PTV scores (from 4 events) will be taken into account.

Class numbers will be restricted so please enter early to avoid disappointment. A waiting list will be kept.

Equine Flu Requirements: TREC GB Equine Flu 2019. [These are mandatory](#)

Unfortunately, as widely publicised, there have been outbreaks of equine flu over the past few months, and as per the website, TREC GB has issued a protocol to be followed for any competitions/training/ events run under the TREC GB banner. Please be aware as a competitor that these are minimum requirements, and the actual event venue may have tighter rules (i.e. vaccinations at 6 monthly intervals). The Board of TREC GB would like to promote, as best practice, the following:

Copies of passports with vaccinations (including the correct information PRIOR to 2014, i.e. the first 2 injections within the correct time, and all subsequent ones done on or within the 365-day timescale every year from 2014 to the present, OR a new course started from 2014, again with every booster on or within 365 days). This should be sent to the organiser/secretary as soon as possible, so checks can be made, and if necessary, a new course can be started. No horse/pony can attend a TREC GB event unless the 2 primary vaccinations have been done and this requires a minimum of 28 days to complete.

Please send a copy of your horse's vaccination certificate to the entries secretary along with your entry before the closing date. Copies can be sent by email or post to the event secretary.

Bring the documents with you and present them to the organisers before unloading your horse. Checks will be carried out at the venue.

EATG Refund policy: No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate to be shown within 5 days of the competition. £4 will be retained for administration costs. In the event of cancellation of the event a voucher will be issued for entry to other EATG TREC Events. If the venue is changed, if you are unable to attend, a voucher for entry for other EATG TREC events will be issued. All entries **must** be paid for before the event by cheque or bank transfer using the correct entry form. EATG's decisions regarding refunds are final. Every effort will be made to be flexible and reasonable. EATG is a non-profit organisation, but has to meet its costs for running events.

GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS

Placing will be decided with the rider gaining the highest combined score from the PTV and Control of Paces phases taking the first prize. In the event of equality the highest score from PTV will take precedence.

RULES AS PER THE TREC GB RULEBOOK AVAILABLE TO DOWNLOAD FROM WWW.TRECGB.COM

Your attention is particularly drawn to Appendix 7 p92 2018 TREC GB Rulebook (4th edition)

1. Competitions are open to all horses and ponies providing that they are a minimum of 4yrs of age.
2. Riders any age, juniors may ride horses and seniors may ride ponies.

3. No rider will be permitted to start any phase of the event unless wearing a hard hat, which meets current standard recommended by the BHS (PAS 015, or ASTM F 1163 and bearing kite mark or SEI) that is properly fitted and fastened with a chinstrap.

4. Riders may choose to wear a body protector during any phase of the competition. If worn, Beta 3 2009 standard is strongly recommended.

5. Tack & dress informal but safe. Riders must wear suitable riding footwear.

6. Standing Martingales and other fixed reins are forbidden. If a running martingale is used, horse must be led from headcollar and lead rope for led PTV obstacles.

7. Whips must not exceed 75cms. Spurs, if worn, must be rounded, not exceeding 3.5cms in length and pointed downwards.

8. The judges and officials decision is final and must be complied with at all times. An Un-corrected error on PTV course will result in a ZERO score for the PTV.

Elimination may result for any of the following reasons: Excessive use of whip, Abusive language, Dangerous riding,

9. No horse or pony may compete more than once in any affiliated class.

Health and Safety

In order for these measures to be effective everyone should take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and should obey the instructions of the organising officials and stewards.

Please ensure Horses/ponies are not left tied up without supervision outside the trailer and clear up any droppings, hay etc, (*We want to be asked back!*). All children to be supervised and dogs kept on a lead at all times.
