- All classes are open to Members of East Anglia TREC Group and other TREC groups.
- There will be an East Anglia TREC Group winter league for all EATG members.
- Any promotional members may pay either 3 x £5.00 on top of entry fee per class or £15.00 straight off to become a member.
- Competitor times for the classes will be split into 2 sections morning = A and afternoon + B, so riders don't need to hang around for too long, the scores will be scored together and results sent out if need be, please bring £2.00 towards the postage.

### 1A./B Clear Round

This Class does not count on the score league board hence £5.00 per round a rosette will be awarded for completing all the obstacles.

### 2A./B Top Score

Open to all. Competitors have a set time of 6 minutes to do the course of 10 obstacles in the correct order and direction, once completed you then carry on doing any obstacles but must be in the correct direction, and you can only do each obstacle up to 3 times including the first round. There is no M/A(control of paces ) in this class.

### 3A./B Pairs

Open to all. Both riders come into the arena, first rider does Canter for the M/A then carry on with all the obstacles, then hi -five to second rider who then does the walk M/A and carries on with the obstacles, this is timed from when you start the canter, M/A and stops when the second rider finishes last obstacle.

**4A./B Newcomer** to TREC Class for newcomer rider / horse combination who have not been placed in any TREC competitions this season.

**5A./B Novice** For Rider / horse combination who have done TREC at level 1 and or Level 2.

### 6A./B Open to all Treccies combinations.

All classes are open to fully paid up Members of East Anglia TREC Group and other TREC groups.

**There will be an East Anglia TREC Group winter league** for all EATG members.

Any promotional riders (these are riders new to TREC and wanting to find out what's it all about before joining) members may pay either 3 x £5.00 on top of entry fee per class or £15.00 straight off to become a member which means your scores are then counted for the league.

**What is Arena TREC?**

Arena TREC focuses on the MA (Control of Paces) and PTV (Obstacle course) phases of TREC and events are usually run in an indoor or outdoor school.

The PTV is a course of 10 optional obstacles, each with a maximum score of 10 points. There is a large range of obstacles designed to test things that would normally be encountered out hacking in the British countryside. You will not be eliminated if there is something that you cannot or do not wish to do. All you have to do is cease forward movement before the obstacle and tell the judge that you are not attempting it. To find out more, please look at the **TREC GB Rulebook**.

The MA phase consists of a 2m wide corridor between 50 and 150m long, along which the rider canters as slowly as possible before returning by walking as fast as possible without breaking pace. A maximum of 15 points for each of the two stages can be attained, i.e. 50% of the full Summer Series marks.

The EATG Winter League will include results from all except the clear round class, held from 19th November 2023 to 31st March 2024 . Points will be awarded for placings (1st = 10 points, 2nd = 9 points, etc) the Horse and rider combination must be the same through the winter series / different combination will start a new combination name. If a competitor is eliminated in the PTV phase, there will be no league points awarded for that round, even if they are placed in the class.

In the event of equal positions after the four events, If still equal, the TOTAL actual PTV scores (from 4 events) will be taken into account.

Riders who are not members of EATG can join in full within 48 hours of the competition for their performance at that event to count.

**Equine Flu Requirements:** TREC GB requires that all equines must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza and that organisers of any events, involving equines, insist that vaccinations are up to date (12-month cycle) and to check passports before horses are unloaded. Full details of the TREC GB Equine Flu Vaccination requirements are available on the website (<https://trecgb.com/trec-gb-equine-flu-requirements/>)

Your horse should be registered on the TREC GB central register by sending a copy of the full vaccination record and horse registration details from the passport to [admin@trecgb.com](mailto:admin@trecgb.com). Alternatively, your horse will be registered by the Entries Secretary for this event, please include a copy of the vaccination certificate and horse registration details when sending your completed entry in.

EATG would also like to have the riders up to date Public Liability Insurance details.

**EATG require all entries to have a copy of the horses up to date flu certificate plus the riders PLI, including the renewal date.**

**GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS**

1. Competitions are open to all horses and ponies providing that they are a minimum of 4 years old for ridden classes and 1 year old for in hand classes.
2. Riders, minimum age of 5 years old, juniors may ride horses and seniors may ride ponies.
3. No rider will be permitted to start any phase of the event unless wearing a correctly fitted hard hat with the chin strap correctly fastened meeting one or more of the current standards as listed below:
  - PAS 015 (2011) provided it has a BSI Kitemark OR an Inspec IC Mark
  - VG1 01.040 (2014-12) provided it has a BSI Kitemark OR an Inspec IC Mark
  - ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), providing it has an SEI mark
  - SNELL E2016, providing it has a SNELL label and number
  - AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards), providing it has an SAI Global mark
4. Riders may choose to wear a body protector during any phase of the competition. If worn, Beta 3 2009 or 2018 standard is recommended.
5. Tack & dress informal but safe. Riders must wear suitable riding footwear.
6. Standing Martingales and other fixed reins are forbidden. If a running martingale is used, horse must be led from headcollar and lead rope for led PTV obstacles.
7. Whips must not exceed 75cms. Spurs, if worn, must be rounded, not exceeding 3.5cms in length and must not point upwards.
8. The judges and officials' decision is final and must be complied with at all times. Un-corrected error on PTV course will result in a ZERO score for the PTV.  
Elimination may result for any of the following reasons: excessive use of whip, abusive language, dangerous riding.
9. The name and contact number of the designated event safeguarding officer (DSO) Jill Perry, and TREC GB designated safeguarding lead (DSL), Trish Donnelly 07926 980022 should be prominently displayed. The DSO must be present on the day of the competition.
10. There may be some changes regarding the hat and body protector standards within the dates, we will advise accordingly.

**Covid19 Requirements.** The current Covid restrictions will be in force on the day. These will be advised to you before the competition. Hand sanitisers will be available at the venue. Other advice may be in force on the day. Look for information displayed on the day.

**This will be based on the advice in force at the time of the competition.**

Please keep your visit to a minimum: Arrive, Compete, Leave!

\* Maintain social distancing.

\* Paperwork will be sent to you before the competition.

\* All horse flu vaccination information must be sent to the organiser before the competition.

\* All persons attending should be aware of others and keep them and yourselves safe.

East Anglia TREC Group and The Venue have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of everyone at this event. In order for these measures to be effective everyone should take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and should obey the instructions of the organiser, officials and stewards.

Please ensure horses and ponies are not left tied up without supervision outside a trailer/lorry as the parking area is not contained.

No dogs allowed and children to attend only if they are under adult supervision.

Clear up any droppings/hay etc. We want to be asked back. 😊

### Helpers are always welcome:

- No judging experience is necessary, you will be given full instructions on what to do.
- A M&S voucher will be given to people who help.
- Also, all EATG Volunteers are recorded and there is a prize of a £50 Ingatestone Voucher for the volunteer of the year.

**EATG Refund policy:** No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate to be shown within 5 days of the competition. £4 will be retained for administration costs. In the event of cancellation of the event, a voucher will be issued for entry to other EATG TREC Events. If the venue is changed, if you are unable to attend, a voucher for entry for other EATG TREC events will be issued. All entries **must** be paid for before the event by cheque or bank transfer using the correct entry form. EATG decisions regarding refunds are final. Every effort will be made to be flexible and reasonable. EATG is a non-profit organization but has to meet its costs for running events.
